Instant Cinema is a new way to experience audio-visual art. An evening of live visuals, electronica and queasy listening at this 21st century cafe culture event hosted by Kino-Kult.

VJ Powerpoint described the way the first event in 2005 came together after a chance meeting with filmmaker dr\_lighthouse "We took over the India Arms and people from all over Portsmouth turned up to help out for free donating projectors, PA and screens". Joining the team in 2006 Pusha2.0 added "the night came together around a group of like minded audio/visualisers who just wanted somewhere to play; a true TAZ". Vision Clash is now an annual fixture of the Portsmouth cultural calendar.

This year the team are taking the show on the road offering a full immersion multi-projector environment showcasing live sets by audio visual artists and laptop musicians; Seatman Separator, Violenski, Ben Ochs and Mark Churcher with Vjs Pusha2.0, dr\_lighthouse and VJ PowerPoint driving the visuals.
